Reminders:

- **Pace of Play:** Be respectful and courteous to all players.
 - 9 holes = **2:05 or less** ~ 5 Holes = **1:25 or less**
 - Our staff will be monitoring pace and your position on the golf course.
 - In most cases, if you do not see the group directly ahead of you in the fairway or on the green, then your group is slow and should increase your pace. The GPS system also provides updates.
 - Wherever the group behind you may be, has no bearing on you being able to slow down or not being caught up to the group ahead of you.
- **Check-In:** It is not necessary to check-in at Pro Shop.
 - Format, flag events, special events and results are posted on the Pro Shop window.
 - The whiteboard depicts which side you are playing and starting hole #.
- **Tee Time:** Arrive at the course at least 10 minutes before your shotgun start time.
 - If your group is not complete at your time, you must tee off. The tardy member(s) will be brought out to you.
- **Scorecards:**
 - Please turn in a group scorecard immediately following play with FIRST & LAST names written legibly with each player's score totaled. If a substitute did play, please make note.
- **Tees: Green**
- **Rules:** A complete list of rules is posted on the Pro Shop window and on the Women's League webpage.
 - Winter Rules – You may improve your lie everywhere except hazards.
 - Drop Areas – Please use marked drop areas on #2, #14 & #17 to help with speed of play.
 - Out of Bounds – Drop closest to the point of entrance no closer to the hole with a one stroke penalty.

Pace of Play Recommendations

- Play "ready golf," which should extend to the putting green.
- Stroke limit per hole is 5 over par.
- Be realistic on when you can hit behind another group to be safe and courteous but also keep play moving.

- All players should be watching where balls go to shorten time spent searching. **Take a drop** if you can't find the ball in a **few minutes**.
- Carts/golf bags should be left on the far side of the green, en route to the next hole. One player can move the cart while the other chips onto the green.
- Have the clubs you need ready when it's your turn to play.
- Score cards should be **marked away** from the green.
