WOMEN'S LEAGUE - 2023 RULES OF PLAY

Arrival – Please arrive **at least 15 minutes prior to your starting time**. There is **no need** to check in at the Pro Shop. Please look to the whiteboard posted outside with information on special events, format, rules & cart numbers.

- If you are not able to attend on any given night, substitutes are encouraged to attend. Subs are not eligible for flag events or weekly prizes.

- Turn in scorecard after play to the Pro Shop. Double check scores and make sure that **BOTH FIRST & LAST NAMES** are on the scorecard along with your total score.

Driving Range

Range balls can be purchased at the Pro Shop. On Tuesday nights league members receive a **discounted rate**.

Pace of Play

Always keep pace with the group in front of you. If you do fall behind, please catch up in a timely manner. Your position on the golf course should always be directly behind the group in front of you. Pace of play is set at **2 hours and 5 minutes for 9 holes & 1 hour and 25 minutes for 5 holes.**

Pro Shop Credit

Credit accumulated throughout the season will be kept in the Pro Shop. Credit can be used at any time and can be used for pro shop merchandise or green/cart fees. Credit must be redeemed by December 1, 2023. After that date all remaining credit will be forfeited.

Weekly Flag Events

Closest to the pin, longest putt, closest 2nd shot, closest 3rd shot, closest chip off the green, longest drives, etc. Winners receive pro shop credit. Subs are not eligible for prizes.

Weekly Updates

Weekly updates will be available on the website under [WOMEN'S LEAGUE](#) for the upcoming week. This will include the past weeks' winners, format for the upcoming week, flag event locations and a listing of scheduled events.

Tees - Play from the **GREEN** tee markers.

Winter Rules - You may improve your lie, no closer to the hole, anywhere on the course except hazards. You must stay in the same situation. You may not move from the rough to fairway or fairway to green.

Drop Areas- Allowed as relief from the Water Hazards or Lateral Hazards on Holes #2, #14, & #17. Proceed to the Drop Area to hit next shot under 1 penalty stroke.

Penalty Areas - Such as the left side of #6, #8, #9, #15 and the right side of #10, #11, #12 & #13 should be treated as follows: Ball should be dropped outside of the penalty area, not nearer the point where the ball last crossed the hazard. Player should add 1 penalty stroke.

Out of Bounds - Defined by white stakes, paint, or fence posts. For pace of play purposes, we are adopting the NEW USGA recommendation ALTERNATIVES to STROKE and DISTANCE. This means you may drop IN THE FAIRWAY from a point of EQUAL DISTANCE to the hole from where your ball went out of bounds under PENALTY of TWO STROKES.

Lost balls – Played under penalty of TWO strokes, ball may be dropped within two club lengths of where original ball was deemed to be lost.

Provisional Ball – If a ball might be lost or out of bounds, to save time, the player is encouraged to play a provisional ball. **Play and practice ready golf.** Hit and putt whenever you are ready and limit your time looking for lost balls. Please fix all divots plus one more on each green.

U.S.G.A. Rules apply in all other situations.

5 Over Par = Maximum Strokes per Hole (i.e., Hole #1 is a Par 4 – maximum number of strokes is 9)
