#### **PACE OF PLAY REMINDER:**

**9 holes = 2:05 or less; 5 holes = 1:25 or less**

Moving forward we will be stressing the pace of play and expecting all groups to adhere to the policy.

**ALL** players regardless of when they tee off should play in the allotted time.

- **Arrive at LEAST 10 minutes prior to your tee time.**
- **If all of your players are not here, then you MUST tee off and we will run them out to you.**
- **If you do not see the group directly ahead of you then you are behind pace and need to speed up.**

#### **Reminders:**

- **Pace of Play: 2:05 or less ~ 5 Holes = 1:25 or less**
  - Be respectful and courteous to all players. Our staff will be monitoring pace and your position.
  - In most cases, if you do not see the group directly ahead of you in the fairway or on the green, then your group is slow and should increase your pace of play. The GPS system also provides updates.
- **Arrival:**
  - Format, flag events and last week's results are posted on the Pro Shop window.
  - The whiteboard depicts which side you are playing and specific cart #. **Red(F-9) Blue(B-9)**
- **Tee Time:**
  - **Arrive at least 10 minutes before your tee time.**
  - If your group is not complete at your time, you must tee off. The tardy member(s) will be brought out to you. We will tee groups off early whenever possible.
- **Scorecards:**
  - Please turn in a group scorecard immediately following play with each player's score totaled legibly. If a substitute did play, please make note.
- **Tees:**
  - **Green**
- **Rules:**
  - Rules are posted on the Pro Shop window and on the league webpage.
  - Winter Rules – You may improve your lie everywhere except hazards.
  - Drop Areas – Please use marked drop areas on #2, #14 & #17 to help with speed of play.
  - Out of Bounds – Drop closest to the point of entrance no closer to the hole with a one stroke penalty.

#### **Today:**

- **Format: 2-Gal Scramble**
  - Pick your partner. Both players tee off. Pick the best shot (ball) and both players hit from that position. You will continue this format until the ball is holed. You will record one score between the two of you.
- **Flag Events: Longest Putt #8 & 12 & Closest 3<sup>rd</sup> Shot #6 & #18**
